Maintained regardless of cost and specified to the highest standards, this example of the Commodore 42 enjoyed a mini refit in 2022 by Fox's in Ipswich including new 6mm teak decks, upgraded Raymarine Navigation Suite and full maintenance works. Benefitting from the most desirable Caterpillar engines, "Tomboy III" will cruise comfortably at 22 knots and can achieve a top speed in the region of 27 knots. This example really needs to be seen to appreciate the time and effort that went into her build and viewing is highly recommended. Layout / Interior

This example of the Hardy Commodore 42 offers comfortable accommodation for 4 guests. When entering in the interior you are greeted by a spacious saloon with the lower helm area located at the forward section. The helm benefits from twin helm seats located on the port side with a large dash encompassing the engine controls and Raymarine navigation suite. There is an overhead panel that houses all the system controls when underway and the engine instrumentation computers. To starboard there is a well-designed Chart area which has an opening panel allowing extra light into the galley when not using the chart area. Behind the chart area a section of the u-shaped saloon seating lifts to provide a clever double navigation seat for use whilst underway. Forward of the helm area steps lead down to the comprehensive galley which spans across the full beam of the boat with the main galley on the Starboard side and the smaller workstation and fitted fridge and freezer on the port side. The galley is well considered and fitted out with premium equipment for all your culinary needs when aboard. There is a set of twin stainless steel sinks countersunk into the luxury Corian worktops and plenty of storage available. Moving forward you enter the Guest cabin which provides twin berths in the format of a V-Shaped bed, to port there is a wardrobe with shelving and a clever chart storage area above, to starboard is the guest ensuite / day heads comprising of Shower, Techma Toilet system and wash hand basin with hot and cold water and storage below. Moving aft of the saloon you enter the Master bedroom suite with a comfortable double bed located off centre and plenty of storage around the outside of the room. The forward bulkhead houses a wardrobe compartment and a recess to house the flatscreen TV. To Starboard, there is a dressing table and entrance to the ensuite. The ensuite benefits from a walk-in shower with a seat, wash hand basin with hot and cold-water set-in Corian countertops and a Techma toilet system. The interior is finished with classic and stylish wood cabinetry throughout, champagne vinyl headlining's, Alcantara saloon seating and the overall look is complimented with an array of soft furnishings, curtains and ocean-air blinds in the Saloon. The external area benefits from generous side decks to provide a full walkaround experience, aft deck with seating and storage, flybridge with upper helm and plenty of seating / storage and a large bathing platform for easy access to the sea for all your water-based activities.

Blending elegant looks, enhanced systems engineering and luxurious accommodation, the Hardy 42, designed by Andrew Wolstenholme, has long been the serious cruiser's choice and offers a smooth ride at more than 25 knots, even in adverse weather conditions.

Wide, safe, walkaround decks with a generously proportioned aft deck and flybridge provide plenty of outdoor living space for relaxing and taking in the view.

Deck:

- Enclosed by bulwarks and solid handrails round the whole boat that can comply with the MCA workboat code and incorporate fender baskets (optional side and aft deck concealed lights)
- windlass on foredeck with local controls at both the lower and flybridge helm positions (option hydraulic)
- Anchor and 60m. chain cable
- Large lazarette locker below lower aft deck plus outboard bracket above
- Hinged access gates through the rails on either side for access ashore and aft onto the bathing platform

Lower Helm Area:

- With twin KAD Suspension helm seats
- Fold-up section of settee providing 2 further pilot seats
- Sliding doors providing access to the side decks either side
- Engine and thruster controls, navigation and communication electronic equipment
- Overhead electrical control console and a dedicated chart table with red lights above

Accommodations:

Central Deck Saloon:

- Comfortable seating for 6 or more
- Dining table with folding leaves and an adjustable height central pillar
- Various lockers units with an optional built-in TV on a retractable bracket
- Bottle locker
- · Glasses locker

- Off the forward cabin with optional separate shower compartment and curved sliding door
- Manual or electric toilet and washbasin set in a dedicated moulded unit

Galley:

- Electric 4-burner ceramic hob (option induction hob)
- Electric fan oven
- Built in microwave (option combined oven and microwave)
- Double sink and mixer tap
- Extensive worktop (option Corian) with stainless steel splash back
- Various lockers and drawers
- General lighting and dedicated lighting above each worktop
- Optional deck head opening through the chart table to give additional light in port
- Dual voltage fridge/freezer
- Waste bin below steps

Flybridge:

- Lockers on 3 side fitted with removable cushions and a Perspex wind shield covering the forward two thirds of the flybridge.
- Console on forward side or centre of flybridge with engine, thruster, trim tab and steering controls, plus duplicates of the electronic equipment at the lower helm
- Twin adjustable helm seats (optional position for seats and console further aft)
- Hinged mast with radar scanner, aerials, sensors etc


